1. Select Locations, Dates, and Program Details

(approx. 4-12 months before the program)

You can let us know the appropriate cities/sites, curriculum, and travel dates or you can complete our development form and/or start with one of our sample itineraries (both of which are included in this booklet). Program costs are based on the specific services designed for each individual group. We can also work with your budget.

2. First Quote and Suggested Itinerary

(approx. 1-2 weeks after our initial contact)

Based on the program details, CEPA Europe will provide a first proposal for your review and suggestions. Once you are completely satisfied, the program proposal and contract is sent for approval by your alumni administration.

3. Program Approval and Booking

(no later than 90 days prior to departure)

The final participant list, rooming list and 10% non-refundable deposit will be due to firmly book the program.

4. Promotion Materials & Recruitment Period

CEPA Europe can support you during this recruitment process, if requested, with a program tailored marketing support. This can include a flyer and/or a power point presentation for your participants, as well as the attendance of a CEPA Europe representative during homecoming.

5. Pre-departure Materials

(2 weeks prior to departure)

We will send you the final itinerary and pre-departure information at least 2 weeks prior to your departure date. This will include your detailed itinerary, day-by-day schedule of activities and locations as well as important notes and contact and emergency phone numbers.

6. Arrival in Europe!

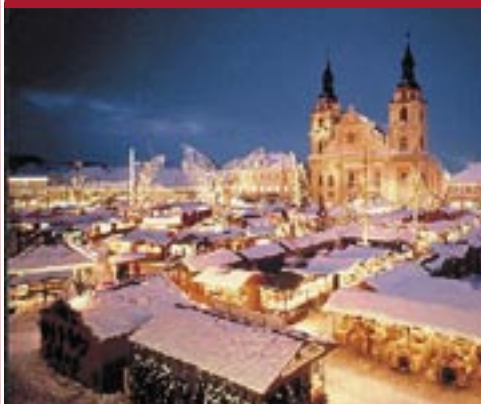

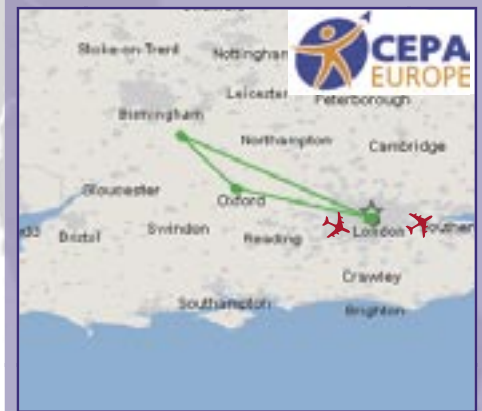

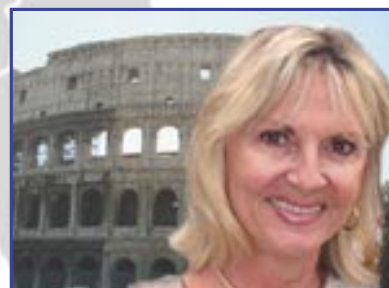
