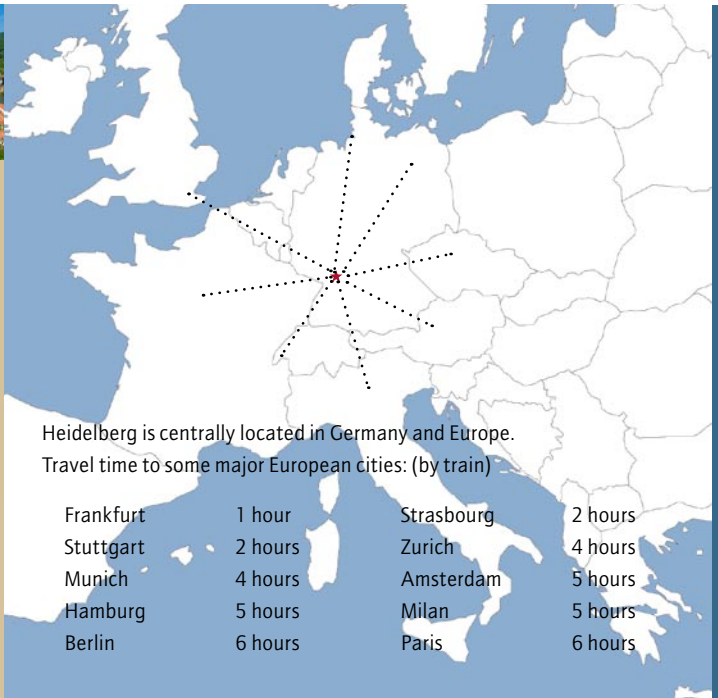


Why Visit Heidelberg?

Day trips from Heidelberg

Located centrally in Europe and in the south west of Germany, Heidelberg is an optimal starting point for excursions and trips to Frankfurt, Stuttgart and Munich as well as major cities in Europe.

Frankfurt: 1 hour by bus or train

Known as the American city of Germany, Frankfurt is also known as the birthplace of Goethe and the financial/commercial center of Germany. The Frankfurt Stock Exchange and European Central Bank are located here.

Stuttgart: 1 ½ hours by bus, 1 hour by train

Stuttgart is famous for its automobile industry. Discover historic buildings, galleries, museums as well as international firms such as Bosch, Porsche, Mercedes-Benz and Hewlett Packard.

Munich: 3 hours by bus or train

The city of Munich has a lot to offer for any student group. Filled with history, culture and Bavarian charm, Munich is the capital of Bavaria and the fairytale King Ludwig castles are not far away. No visit to Munich is complete without a visit to the "Hofbräuhaus", which is the Royal Court Brewery.
