Cost of Living

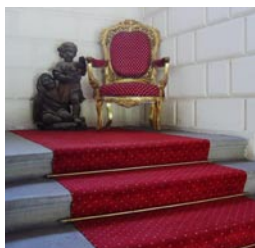
Since Strasbourg is a university city, it is a very affordable location for study abroad programs and students' budgets.

Day trips from Strasbourg

Located centrally in Europe and in the eastern border of France, Strasbourg is an optimal starting point for excursions and trips to Paris, Geneva and Heidelberg as well as all major cities in Europe.

Paris: 2:20 hours by TGV train

One of the most popular destinations in the world, the city of Paris and surrounding region can be easily reached by train from Strasbourg. The numerous iconic landmarks, world-famous institutions and "Parisian lifestyle" await.

Brussels: 5 hours by bus

Brussels is a major center of international politics, location of the EU institutions, NATO and many other international organizations. The international community of diplomats, lobbyists and journalists in Brussels is one of the largest in Europe.

Geneva: 2-4 hours by bus or train

The city of Geneva is an important global city and known worldwide as the center for diplomacy and international co-operations. The United Nations, Red Cross and many international company headquarters are located in Geneva, also sometimes referred to as the "Peace Capital" of the world.
